Some people have characterized the recall as mean-spirited or divisive, casting the Parks and Recreation commissioners as victims of an extremist group of malcontents. Let's look at what has led to the recall.

They have destroyed a substitute family for the lonely and alienated, one that provided access to vital social services, and have not replaced it for six months. They have dismissed that community's pleas to reconsider, and wait, and have launched a cover-up in the form of the ad hoc committee that is busily finding ways to spend much more money while downgrading and outsourcing social services.

These commissioners need to be replaced with people who will work with the community they serve, not impose their will on us!
